### **Six Simple Guidelines for Prayer Time**

These simple guidelines are meant to serve as tools to help our meetings for prayer get started, encourage newcomers, and motivate the more timid to pray aloud.

- 1. Small groups 6-8 per group
- 2. Specific requests gathered and distributed by the prayer group leader
- 3. Short prayers secret of the success of small group prayer
- 4. Subject by subject pray in one accord, one subject at a time
- 5. Simple prayers keep it simple, resist temptation to impress
- 6. Silent periods gives time for those who are more timid to participate
